<b>Men &amp; Women</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Annual physical</li> <li>• Colorectal cancer screening</li> <li>• Blood pressure screening</li> <li>• Lipid disorder (cholesterol) screening</li> <li>• Depression screening</li> <li>• Vaccines:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Influenza (Flu)</li> <li>• Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Td/Tdap)</li> <li>• Varicella (Chickenpox)</li> <li>• Zoster (Shingles)</li> <li>• HPV Vaccine</li> <li>• Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)</li> <li>• Pneumococcal (pneumonia)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>Pregnant Women</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hepatitis B virus (HBV) infection screening</li> <li>• Syphilis screening</li> <li>• Screening for iron deficiency anemia</li> <li>• Breastfeeding counseling</li> <li>• Screening for Rh (D) Incompatibility</li> <li>• Screening for Asymptomatic Bacteriuria</li> </ul>

The following services and immunizations are recommended for adults with certain factors related to their health, job or lifestyle that put them at higher risk

<b>Men &amp; Women</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aspirin for the prevention of cardiovascular disease</li> <li>• Alcohol misuse screening and behavioral counseling in primary care</li> <li>• Screening for Type 2 diabetes mellitus</li> <li>• Nutrition counseling (behavioral counseling in primary care to promote a healthy diet in adults at increased risk for cardiovascular disease)</li> <li>• Vaccines               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meningococcal</li> <li>• Hepatitis A</li> <li>• Hepatitis B</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Men</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) screening</li> </ul>
<b>Women</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Genetic Risk Assessment and <i>BRCA</i> Mutation Testing for Breast and Ovarian Cancer Susceptibility (with family history)</li> </ul>
